Meeting May 15, 2019

Grange Hall, North Clarendon

A regular meeting began at 6PM with 17 people in attendance for a presentation by Jason Smiley - The Devil's Cabinet: The Eddy Family of Spirit Mediums. We are grateful to Jason for coming to Clarendon and putting on what was an excellent talk. We look forward to his book being published.

Following the regular meeting the annual meeting was held starting at 7:40. A quorum was present: Janet Keefe, Ed Congdon, Peter and Jan Savage, Ellen Whooley, Phil and Becky Mandolare and Bob Underhill.

Approval of last year's minutes - Ed Congdon made a motion to accept, Jan seconded.

Election of Officers: Peter's resignation as Vice President was accepted and Phil Mandolare was nominated to replace him. Phil accepted the nomination. Peter will continue as Web Master. Becky was nominated as Treasurer and accepted the nomination. Bob requested other nominations, none heard, motion to accept as presented, Ed moved, Jan seconded, all were elected unopposed. Peter indicated new Officers might need to be reported to the State immediately. Bob will check.

The Financial Statement for the year ending 12/31/18 was handed out and there were no questions as presented.

The Annual Report as found in the Annual Town Report was handed out detailing the accomplishments in 2018. Bob noted that we were currently at about 600 entries, up from the 350 noted in the report.
