Peter will look at the website to determine how best to sell the 1976 history book.

Bob and Becky will be picking a day to go through certain old materials in the town vault.

Edwin Congdon donated a copy of the 1961 Bicentennial Program for Clarendon. Bob will get it put up onto the website.

Norm Harris donated a Centennial Edition set of Windham County 1869 maps published by F.W. Beers.

Phil will look at his many artifacts discovered in Clarendon for possible postings on our site.

There was also a discussion about using the 2018 Town Meeting and the 2018 Town-wide Tag Sale event (as had been suggested earlier this year by the Philbrooks) as opportunities to publicize ourselves and maybe sell some of our books.
