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ADDITIONAL ARCHITECTURAL OR STRUCTURAL DESCRIPTION:

Five-bay facade with center entrance. Gabled hood with arched soffit over entrance, which has three-quarter length sidelights, fluted enframement and jambs, and corner blocks. 6/6 windows with molded casings; no lintels. Box cornice with fascia board and returns. Two bays deep. Rear wood frame ell. Common bond brickwork.

RELATED STRUCTURES:

Carriage barn at rear.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

A well-preserved 1 1/2 story brick Federal style house, this building is one of the few remaining structures dating from the early 1800's in the village of North Clarendon.
