- Pat Moore showed us a 1911 vacuum cleaner that had been her great grandmothers
- Dave Potter shared a very large mid-1800's map of Vermont that has been in his family.
- Carla Peck shared a fan-style genealogy chart of her family that goes back to early settlers of Clarendon and all the way back to Rhode island & Boston, including an ancestor, Mary Dyer, that was hung in Boston in 1659 for being a Quaker.
- Jim Philbrook showed us an old carving tool of unknown usage
- Donna Brewer shared photos & documents of the Keyes & Tubbs families.
